Diction - Word Choice

Diction

Diction is word choice, or the style of speaking that a writer, speaker, or character uses. The **diction** that you use when you speak or write should be matched to purpose or audience.



Denotation	Connotation
Literal meaning of the word (what you find in the dictionary)	The emotional associations for that word
Gray \rightarrow "A color between white and black"	Gray \rightarrow uncertainty, old, the middle ground, sadness, gloomy, fear, angry
